


au Easy Setting

By setting au ID, you can use various services provided by au such as "au Kantan Kessai" which allows you to purchase applications from the auスマートパス (au Smart Pass) or Google Play. Main setting items are as follows.

Register your au phone number or a character string for au ID (user ID). au ID password Register password for using au ID.

- "au ID" which is already used by another user cannot be set
- If you skip the operation of "au Easy Setting" at that time, you can set au ID later. In such case, on the iida Home, → Tap "au Easy Setting"





Backing up E-mail

You can back up E-mail. Backed up data is saved on a microSD ™ memory card (/storage/sdcard1/private/au/email/BU/) when a microSD ™ memory card is attached. If a microSD™ memory card is not attached, data is saved on the internal storage (/storage/sdcard0/private/au/email/






