

isai V30+ Setting Guide

Thank you for purchasing the "isai V30+" (simply called the "product" from here on). This "Setting Guide" describes the basic operations and initial settings for using the product.

Before using the product, be sure to read the "Notes on Usage" to ensure correct and safe use.

* For details, refer to the "Basic Manual application" installed on the product or "取扱説明書 (詳細版) (Full Instruction Manual)" (Japanese) available on the au homepage.

Learning the Basic Operations

Basic operations of the keys

- **Power key (rear)**
 - **Power ON**
Press and hold the power key.
 - **Power OFF**
Press and hold the power key → Select [Power off] → [POWER OFF]
 - **Sleep mode**
Press the power key in operation to switch to sleep mode.
 - **Cancel sleep mode**
Press the power key in sleep mode to display the lock screen.
- **Display (Touch panel)**
Directly touch an item or button displayed on the screen to operate.
- **Task button**
Check running applications. Press and hold an app while it is running to start up Multi Window.
- **Home button**
Use it to display the Home screen.
- **Back button**
Returns to the previous screen.

Unlocking the screen

Swipe on the lock screen.

Basic operations of the touch panel

The display of the product is a touch panel and you can touch directly with your finger to operate.

- **Tap/Double Tap**
Lightly touch an icon or item and then immediately release your finger. Tapping the same place twice is called a double tap.
- **Touch and hold**
Keep touching the screen.
- **Slide**
While your finger is lightly touching the screen, move it in the desired direction.
- **Flick (Swipe)**
Quickly move (flicking) your finger up, down, right, or left.
- **Pinch**
Touch the screen with two fingers and widen (pinch-out) or narrow (pinch-in) the fingers' distance.
- **Drag**
Keep touching items or icons and trace to the desired position.

Basic operations to input characters

This product uses the software keyboard displayed at the bottom of the screen to enter characters. Tap the keys on the screen to enter characters.

- 1 Display the characters assigned in reverse order.
- 2 Moves the cursor to the right/left and changes the range of characters when converting characters.
- 3 Enters pictograms/symbols/emoticons.
- 4 Switches the input mode.
- 5 Switches upper case/lower case of entering character.
- 6 Inputs the characters of each key.
- 7 Deletes the character to the left of the cursor.
- 8 Inputs a space and converts characters in Hiragana-Kanji input mode.
- 9 Start a new line/confirm the characters input.

Flick input

You can flick the key up, down, right, or left to enter a character. Touch and hold the key to display the candidates that can be entered by flicking (flick guide). You can also input by flicking after confirming the candidates which can be entered.

How to view the notification panel

When the notification icons appears on the left side of the status bar, slide the status bar down to open the notification panel to check overview of the notification or launch the application.

1 Slide down the status bar
 2 The notification panel appears.

Setting Application authority

When launching the applications/functions to access the functions or information of the product for the first time, the confirmation screen appears to request the permission for the access authority. When the confirmation screen appears, confirm the contents and tap "DENY" or "ALLOW".

- If the application authority is not allowed, applications/functions may not be launched or using functions may be restricted.
- The explanation screen may be displayed depending on the application/function. Also, the confirmation screen may be displayed several times or the display may be different. Check the displayed contents carefully, follow the onscreen instructions.
- In this manual, description of the confirmation screens may be omitted.

Initial Settings: STEP 1

This section describes the initial settings screen that appears when you turn on the power for the first time.

Starting initial settings

- **Changing the language**
- **Setting up Accessibility**

[日本語 (日本)] → select language → [英語 (United States)]
 After switching to the English display, [Accessibility] → review the precautions, [SETTINGS] → set Accessibility → [ON] → [OK]

* Once you select your desired language, the language for the initial settings screen also changes. From here on, follow the onscreen instructions.

* If the language was not switched via the initial settings, switch the language via the following procedures.
 On the Home screen, [設定 (Settings)] → "一般 (General)" tab → [言語と入力 (Language & input)] → [言語 (Language)] → [言語の追加 (ADD LANGUAGE)] → [English] → drag "English (United States)" and drop it at the very top.

The folder names will not be changed from the language of the initial settings. Convert the folder names contained in "Setting Guide" (this manual), "Basic Manual", "Notes on Usage" into Japanese as per the following and operate.

Initial Settings: STEP 2

Setting Wireless LAN (Wi-Fi®)

Using the wireless LAN (Wi-Fi®) function, you can access to the Internet using a wireless LAN environment built in your home or a public wireless LAN environment away from home.

When setting the wireless LAN (Wi-Fi®) as described in this guide, you need to be in an environment where the radio waves can be received from the wireless LAN device or public wireless LAN that you want to access to. Check the following information before setting the wireless LAN (Wi-Fi®) function.

SSID	The name set for the wireless LAN device or public wireless LAN service that you are connecting to
Password	The password for connecting to the wireless LAN device or public wireless LAN service

- * Connection to all public wireless LAN services is not guaranteed.
- * You may need a separate contract with a service provider to use some public wireless LAN services.
- * Enabling the wireless LAN (Wi-Fi®) function uses a lot of battery power. We recommend turning off the wireless LAN (Wi-Fi®) function when not using it.

1 Set Internet connection
 2 Enter Password → [CONNECT] → confirm the connection → [NEXT]

[Wi-Fi] of "Wi-Fi" → tap the network that you are connecting to
 * If you do not set up, tap [NEXT].

* This step is not required if you select a wireless LAN (Wi-Fi®) network without security settings.

Initial Settings: STEP 3

Setting up Google account

You can use online services provided by Google, such as Gmail and Google Play, by setting up a Google account. This section describes how to set up an account on the initial settings screen that appears when you turn on the power for the first time.

User name	Register your Google account (user ID) and the characters that you want to use as your mail address. You can register a desired name, but a name already registered by another user cannot be set.
Password	Register password for the Google account.

- 1 [Set up as new] → [Copy your data]
- 2 [More options] → [Create account]
- 3 Enter your "First name" and "Last name" → [NEXT]
- 4 Enter your birthday and gender → [NEXT]
- 5 Enter your user name → [NEXT]
- 6 Enter your password → re-enter the password → [NEXT]
- 7 Confirm the contents → [YES, I'M IN]
- 8 Confirm the contents → [I AGREE]
- 9 [NEXT]
- 10 Set whether to register fingerprint
- 11 Confirm the Google service contents → [AGREE]
- 12 Meet your Google Assistant → [NEXT]
- 13 Set whether to use the Google Assistant

Check legal documents → place checkmarks on "I agree" → [DONE]

Initial Settings: STEP 5

au Initial Settings

When you have set an au ID, you can use various au services including "au Simple Payment Service" which offers you a simple way to purchase applications from au Smart Pass and Google Play.

- After completing initial settings, you can also setup au services on the Home screen by tapping [Settings] → "General" tab → [au Settings Menu] → [au Initial Setting].

- 2 Place checkmark on "Update", if you want to update pre-installed applications.
- 3 Enter a security number → [次へ (Next)]
- 4 Enter a password → [同意して次へ (Agree and next)]
- 5 [次へ (Next)]
- 6 [次へ (Next)]
- 7 [ALLOW]
- 8 Place checkmarks on apps to install → [Next]
- 9 Place checkmarks on contents to set → [Next]
- 10 [Finish]

* 1 If you have registered an au ID previously, steps 3 and 4 are not displayed. Proceed to step 5.
 * 2 The security number is the four-digit security code you wrote on the application form.
 * 3 A confirmation screen is displayed for permission several times. Continue by following the on-screen instructions.
 * 4 If "Select apps" is displayed in the "Backed up" field, you can check the application by tapping.
 * 5 If you have backup data in "Data Storage App" application, the data can be returned, by tapping "Data Storage App".

au-mail Settings

- To use au-mail, subscription to LTE NET is required. If you did not subscribe it when you purchased the product, contact an au shop or Customer Service Center.
- For initial setting, please perform in good signal reception in Japan. It may not be set correctly where the signal reception is bad or while moving. The initial setting cannot be performed via Wi-Fi® communications.
- Depending on the time, the initial setting takes about 30 seconds to 3 minutes. Please wait while the "Eメールアドレスの設定中です。しばらくお待ちください。" (The e-mail address is in setting. Please wait.) message appears.

- On the Home screen, []
- The "License agreement" of au mail app appears, and confirm the contents → [AGREE] → follow the onscreen instructions
- Confirm e-mail address → [閉じる (Close)]
* If the confirmation screen appears, check the content and follow the onscreen instructions.
- The au-mailbox screen is displayed.

Changing your au-mail address

- On the Home screen, []
- [] → [Change Address/Setting Filter]
- [Eメールアドレスの変更へ (To change e-mail address)]
- Enter the security number → [送信 (Send)]
- The confirmation screen of changing E-mail address appears, and confirm the contents → [承諾する (I accept)]
- Enter e-mail address → [送信 (Send)]
- [OK]
- [閉じる (Close)]

The au-mailbox screen is displayed.

Confirming your au-mail address

- On the Home screen, []
- [] → [E-mail information]
- Your e-mail address appears in the E-mail address field.

"Basic Manual application"

Downloading "Basic Manual application"

- On the Home screen, [Basic Functions] → [Basic Manual]
- [UPDATE] → [CONTINUE]
* If confirmation screens are displayed, follow the onscreen instructions to operate.
- The Basic Manual cover is displayed.

Using "Basic Manual application"

- On the Home screen, [Basic Functions] → [Basic Manual]
- Confirm contents displayed → []
- The Basic Manual cover is displayed.

* Packet communications fees are charged for downloading the "Basic Manual application" (no charges for Wi-Fi® connections).

Making a Call

Entering a phone number to make a call

- On the Home screen, []
- Enter a phone number → []

Calling from Contacts

- On the phone screen, tap "Contacts" tab
- Tap the other party to be called
* Tap [] to skip the contact details screen and directly make a call.
- On the contact details screen, tap a phone number

Calling from Call logs

- On the phone screen, tap "Call logs" tab
- Tap the other party to be called
- Tap a phone number

Receiving a Call

You can receive a call in the following steps.

- During an incoming call, [Answer]
- The call starts.
- [End] to end the call

Receiving a call during sleep mode

- Swipe "Answer" in any direction during an incoming call
- The call starts.
- [End] to end the call

Rejecting an incoming call

You can reject a call, by tapping "End" during an incoming call. When you reject a call, the caller is informed that there is no response.

- During an incoming call, [End]

Transferring Contacts

You can transfer the data from your previous phone to the product using a microSD memory card.

- Save the contacts (address book) from your previous phone to a microSD memory card, and insert the card into the product
Refer to the instruction manual of your previous phone, etc. on how to save the contacts.
- On the Home screen, [Basic Functions] → [Contacts]
- [] → [Manage contacts] → [Import]
* When a contact is not registered, tap [] → [Import] → the import source to proceed to step 5. If a saving location screen appears, select the desired account or location.
- [SD card] → [OK]
* If a saving location screen appears, select the desired account or location.
- Place checkmarks on the item to be imported → [IMPORT]
- [IMPORT]
* When the import is complete, "Contacts imported" appears.

How to Transfer Data from the au Settings Menu

You can restore/store data from your previous au phone to this product using a microSD memory card or au servers.

- If you restore data using au server, store the data using your previous au phone to the au server in advance. You need to set up an au ID to use the au server. (If your previous au phone does not have the au Settings Menu, use the au Cloud app.)
- If you restore data using microSD memory card, save the data using your previous au phone to a microSD memory card. (If your previous au phone does not have the au Settings Menu, use the au backup app.)

- On the Home screen, [Settings]
- "General" tab → [au Settings Menu]
- [Data Transfer]
* If the terms of use appears, check the content and follow the onscreen instructions.
- [機種変更はこちら (Model changing is here)]
* Perform data transfer according to the screen guidance.

If you want to use the "Data Storage App" application to automatically save your photos, contacts, etc. to the au server, you can set it up by following the procedure below.

- On the Home screen, [Settings] → "General" tab → [au Settings Menu] → [Backup Setting]

Reducing Battery Consumption

Using Battery Saver

Set up to switch to Battery Saver when the battery is running low.

- On the Home screen, [Settings]
- "General" tab → [Battery]
- [Battery saver]
- [Extended]/[Maximum]

Setting Battery saver

- On the Home screen, [Settings]
- "General" tab → [Battery]
- [Battery saver]
- [Edit mode]
* "Extended" is set on this screen.
- Set the battery saver settings if necessary → [SAVE]

Setting screen brightness and screen timeout

Setting screen brightness

- On the Home screen, [Settings]
- "Display" tab → drag the "Brightness" slider to the right and left to adjust the brightness

Setting screen timeout

- On the Home screen, [Settings]
- "Display" tab → [Screen timeout]
- Tap the time until screen turns off
