Introduction

Thank you for buying the "TORQUE G03" (simply called the "product" from here on). In this guide, settings and precautions for using the product are described. For explanations of basic functions, refer to "Basic Manual".

Basic Operation

For explanations of basic functions, refer to "Basic Manual".

《Home Screen (Standard Home)》

Diagram of the TORQUE G03 home screen with callouts for various features:

- Power button / fingerprint sensor**: Located at the top of the device.
- Turning the Power On**: Press and hold the power button until the charging light turns on.
- Displaying Home screen**: From the Start screen, tap the "Start" icon and slide/flick toward "START" to display the Home screen. Slide/flick toward "CAMERA"/"PHONE" to activate camera/phone.
- Navigation bar**: Located at the bottom of the screen, containing icons for BACK, HOME, and RECENTS.
- Display**: Touch directly with your finger to operate.

Character entry

For character entry, there are flick input and input by tapping a key repeatedly.

Diagrams illustrating character entry methods:

- Flick input**: Touch the screen and flick up/down/left/right to input characters.
- Long-touch**: Keep touching a screen to input characters.
- Slide**: While lightly touching the screen, trace to the desired direction to input characters.
- Zoom in/Zoom out**: With two fingers on the screen, widen your fingers (zoom in) or close them (zoom out).
- Drag**: To move an item, icon, etc., lightly touch the screen and slide it to the desired position.

Setting Silent mode

- Press and hold the volume down button on the left side of the product for at least one second to set the Silent mode to ON/OFF.
- To change the Silent mode type, while in the Silent mode, press the volume up button / the volume down button → Tap [Vibrate] / [Mute] / [Drive]. Alternatively, tap Apps → [Settings] → [Sound] → [Silent mode] → [Silent mode type] to change the type.

Setting App permissions

When you first activate app/function that access the functions or information of the product, a confirmation screen for requesting access permission appears. When the screen for confirmation is displayed, confirm the content and tap "DENY"/"ALLOW". For some apps/functions, an explanation screen for the permission appears. A confirmation screen may appear in several times and its content may vary. Confirm the content and follow the on-screen instructions. In this manual, description of such confirmation screen may be omitted.

Initial Settings

When you turn on the product for the first time after purchasing the product, follow the on-screen instructions to set language, functions and services.

Setting up Google account

Set up Google account to use Google applications such as "Gmail", "Play Store", "Duo". Setting items are as below (besides the items below, register "First" name and "Last" name).

User name	Register your Google account (user ID) and a character string for mail address. You can register a desired name, but a name already registered by another user cannot be set.
Password	Register password for the Google account.

Initial Setup Screenshots:

- ようこそ**: Tap "日本語 (日本)" to select "English". → Select the language region.
- Welcome**: Tap [LET'S GO].
- Welcome to your KYV41**: [Set up as new] → If you restore a backup or copy from a device, select [Copy your data] and follow the on-screen instructions.
- Get connected**: Set up the Wi-Fi[®] network to connect as required. If you do not set up, tap [Use cellular network for setup] → [CONTINUE]. Tap [Don't use any network for setup] → [CONTINUE]. Continue by following the on-screen instructions.
- Sign in with your Google account**: [More options] → [Create account] → If you have a Google account, enter a mail address or phone number → [NEXT].

Initial Setup Screenshots (Continued):

- Create a Google Account**: Enter your name.
- How you'll sign in**: Create a Gmail address for signing in to your Google Account.
- Create a strong password**: Create a strong password with a mix of letters, numbers and symbols.
- Add your phone number**: Confirm/Change the country name and phone number → [NEXT] → [VERIFY]. * If you do not set up, tap "SKIP".
- Check the contents, then [I AGREE]**: Confirm the contents, then [I AGREE].
- Check the contents, then [NEXT]**: Check the contents, then [NEXT].
- Security type**: [ADD FINGERPRINT] → Tap the type of security → Follow on-screen instructions to set security and notification. * If you do not set up, tap [Skip] → [SKIP ANYWAY].
- Location History**: [CONTINUE] → Check Google app permissions, then [YES I'M IN]. * If you do not enable, tap "NO THANKS".
- Teach the Assistant to recognize your voice**: [GET STARTED] → Follow on-screen instructions to set voice recognition. * If you do not set up, tap "DO IT LATER".
- Anything else?**: Set up other settings as required. * If you do not set up, tap "ALL SET".
- Accelerated Location**: Check the contents and mark the check box, then [NEXT]. * If you do not set up, tap "NEXT".

*1 Text message for Google verification code will be sent to the set phone number.

au Easy Setting

By setting au ID, you can use various services provided by au such as "au Kantan Kessai" which allows you to purchase applications from the au スマートパス (au Smart Pass) or Google Play. Main setting items are as follows.

au ID*	Register your au phone number or a character string for au ID (user ID).
au ID password	Register password for using au ID.

* "au ID" which is already used by another user cannot be set.

- If you skip the operation of "au Easy Setting" at that time, you can set au ID later. In that case, operate from Apps menu → [ツール (Tools)] → [au ID Setting].

au Easy Setting Screenshots:

- Welcome to au**: Welcome to au screen → [Next].
- au ID Registration**: [Register "au ID"] → [Next].
- au ID Setting**: [au IDの設定・保存 (Set and save au ID)]
- Enter the security code**: Enter the security code → [OK]. * Default value is a four-digit number written at subscription.
- Enter a security password**: Enter a security password → [設定 (Settings)] → [終了 (Exit)]
- Update**: [Update] / [Skip update] → [Next].
- Terms of Use of au Services**: Check the terms and conditions (reading requires), [Agree] → [Next].
- Automatic Backup Setting**: [Turn Auto Backup on] / [Turn Auto Backup off] → [Next]. * To back up photos and contacts to au server automatically using "Data Storage App", tap "Turn Auto Backup on".
- Home Screen Setting**: Check the contents, then [Activate] / [Skip activation] → [Next]. * In "Basic Manual" of the product, the operations on Home screen of "Standard Home" is provided as examples. Tap [Skip activation] here.

Initial Setup Screenshots (Continued):

- Texting While Walking Alert**: [Activate] / [Skip activation] → [Next].
- Lookout for au**: [Activate] / [Skip activation] → [Next].
- データを探す**: When the "データを探す (Restore data)" screen is displayed, mark data type to be restored → [次へ (Next)].
- おすすめアプリ**: Select apps to install → [次へ (Next)].
- Initial Setting Completed**: [Finish].

*1 To complete the initial setting of Lookout for au, permit the access permission on each request screen.

E-mail

To use E-mail (@ezweb.ne.jp), subscription to LTE NET is required.
If you did not subscribe it when you purchased the product, contact an au shop or Customer Service Center.
Your E-mail address is determined automatically after initial setting. You can change the E-mail address later.

Initial settings * You cannot make initial settings in Wi-Fi® communication.

1 Home screen → [E-mail]

2 Check your E-mail address → [閉じる (Close)]

3 Check the contents, [同意する (Agree)] → [完了 (Done)]*1

*1 If a description screen for the E-mail function is displayed, follow the on-screen instructions.

Checking your E-mail address

1 Home screen → [E-mail]

2 [E-mail information]

3 Your E-mail address is displayed.

Changing your E-mail address

1 Home screen → [E-mail]

2 [E-mail information] → [Change Address/Setting Filter]

3 [E-mail information] → [E-mail address change]

4 Enter the security code → [送信 (Send)]

5 Check the contents, then [承諾する (I accept)]

6 Enter E-mail address → [送信 (Send)]

7 [OK]

8 [閉じる (Close)]

Basic Manual App

Download "Basic Manual app"

1 Apps menu → [サポート (Support)] → [Basic Manual]

2 [UPDATE]

3 Apps menu → [サポート (Support)] → [Basic Manual]

4 The front cover of Basic Manual is displayed.

* If an instruction screen (how to use this application) is displayed, follow the on-screen instructions.

Making a Call

Adding new contact and making a call

1 Apps menu → [コミュニケーション (Communication)] → [Contacts]

2 Enter necessary items → [SAVE]

3 Home screen → [Phone] → Tap "RECENTS" tab

4 Tap "☎" of a party to call

Checking your own phone number (Profile)
Operate as follow to check your own phone number.
Apps menu → [Settings] → [Profile] → Profile screen appears.

Receiving a Call

You can receive a call in the following steps.

Calling

1 Receiving screen → [ANSWER]

2 Calling starts.

3 To end the call, [電話切替 (End Call)]

4 Receiving the screen in sleep mode or while the start screen is displayed

Follow the on-screen instructions.
* To answer the call, slide "☎" right.

Answering with Auto answering

Answer by the answering memo message and record a message of the party when you cannot answer calls.

1 Receiving screen → Tap the operation panel

2 [Auto answering]

3 [RECORD]

4 The caller hears the guidance.

5 To answer the call, slide "☎" right.

Answering with SMS

Reject an incoming call and answer with SMS.
Operate as follow to answer with SMS.

Receiving screen → Tap the operation panel → [Message] → Select a message → [SEND] → SMS message is sent.

Forwarding an incoming call without answering

Forward an incoming call to the forwarding phone number or remote operation of voice mail service.
Forward the incoming call in the following steps.

Receiving screen → Tap the operation panel → [Call forward] → [FORWARD] → The incoming call is forwarded.

Setting Display

Describes how to set brightness level and backlight time.

Adjusting the screen brightness level

1 Apps menu → [Settings] → [Display]

2 Slide the indicator of "Brightness level" left/right.
* To make brighter, slide the indicator right. To make darker, slide the indicator left.

3 Increasing the backlight time of the screen

4 [Sleep] → Select the lighting time

Setting Wi-Fi®

Use your home Wireless LAN (Wi-Fi®) or public wireless LAN to connect to the Internet.
Main settings are as follows.

Select Wi-Fi® network for connection	Search for and connect to an available Wi-Fi® network.
WPS system	Use for registration of access point compatible with Wi-Fi Protected Setup™ with WPS mark.

* If you turn on wireless LAN (Wi-Fi®) function, battery consumption increases. You are recommended to turn wireless LAN (Wi-Fi®) function to OFF when not using wireless LAN (Wi-Fi®) function.

1 Apps menu → [Settings]

2 [Wi-Fi]

3 [OFF]
* Indication changes to "ON".

4 Available Wi-Fi® networks are detected automatically and their SSIDs appear in the Wi-Fi® networks.

5 Select the Wi-Fi® network to connect to*1 → [CONNECT]*2

*1 If the Wi-Fi® network you want to connect to cannot be detected, tap "Add network" and add the network manually.
*2 To connect to a protected Wi-Fi® network, enter the password (security key) and tap "CONNECT". The password (security key) is set with the Wi-Fi® network. For details, contact with the network administrator.

Using a WPS System Access Point

WPS button

1 [Wi-Fi] → [Advanced] → [WPS Push Button]

2 Press the Wi-Fi Protected Setup button* on the Wi-Fi router to set the access point to WPS mode, and the product automatically searches for and registers an access point.
* May be indicated as "WPS" or as a symbol such as "W".


3 WPS Pin Entry

4 Enter displayed PIN code for access point, then registration starts.


Viewing/Playing Data

By transferring data from the previously used au phone to au a microSD™ memory card, you can insert the microSD memory card into this product and view/play still image or movie data using "File Commander" in the product. When you activate for the first time, the Terms and Conditions appears. Follow the on-screen instructions.

* Copyrighted data on the previously used au phone cannot be transferred to the product. However, some Chaku Uta Full®, Video Clip, Chaku Uta Full Plus® may be able to be transferred and played on the product with the same phone number by backing up with LISMO Port Ver 4.2 or later.

Transferring data from au Settings Menu


Restore/back up data from/to your previously used au phone to/from this product using microSD card or the au server.

- To return data using an au server, store the data from the old au phone to the au server beforehand. Setting au ID is required for using the au server (If the old au phone does not have an au Settings Menu, use the Friends Note app or au Cloud app).
- For restoring data using microSD memory card, save the data to the microSD memory card using your previously used au phone in advance. (If the old au phone has not au Settings Menu, use au backup app).


